The Behavioral and Social Science department is deliberating whether to maintain or deactivate the ANTH AA-T degree given the lack of course-section offerings and degrees awarded over the last 5 years. Without a full-time faculty member to offer courses, support declared ANTH majors, and build curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular opportunities for students, the program cannot grow.

Fall Data:

- A total of 242 students enrolled in the course.

ANTH course-section enrollment has declined since FA20-SP21 from 127 students to FA23-SP24 to 29 students.

If your program has seen a significant decline in enrollment over the past 4 years, what resources or support would be helpful to improve program enrollment and access?

ANTH needs a full-time faculty in order to the needed course-sections to be offered, more AA-T degrees to be awarded, and more support can be offered in and out of the classroom.

What is the program doing to increase student enrollment or access?

Without a full-time ANTH faculty member, the program will not be able to increase enrollment or access.

What is your program's overall course success rate? How has it changed over the past 4-5 years? The overall success rate has ranged from a low of 33% (FA23) to a high of 84% (FA22).

Which groups are experiencing equity gaps in your program for success rate and/or retention rate?

Yes, there is an equity gap in Fall semesters for African-American, American Indian, Asian, Hispanic/Latino, and Middle Eastern students. And Hispanic/Latino students in Spring semesters.

What department/discipline (or institutional) factors may be contributing to these lower rates of success for these groups of students?

Without a full-time ANTH faculty member, the program will not be able to increase success rates.

How has this data shaped your comprehensive program review goals and action steps?

This data makes clear that without a full-time ANTH faculty member, the program will not be able to develop program goals, delineate action steps, offer course-sections, evaluate SLOs and PLOs, or increase degrees awarded.

Distance Education ANTH courses have been ofered, but it is unknown how RSI was achieved by the part-time faculty member who taught the course-sections.

If there are no differences, what did the program do to achieve that? The average success rate for DE ANTH courses was 61% for in-person and 79% for DE during Fall terms. No DE ANTH courses were offered during Spring terms.
