Action steps for this academic year.:

We have consistently had an increase in enrollment. In comparing the Spring 2023 to Spring 2024 semesters, we had a 4% increase in enrollment with a 2% increase in retention and a 4% increase in success rate. In comparing the Fall 2022 to Fall 2023 semester, we had an 11% increase in enrollment while maintaining the retention rate and a minimal drop (1%) in the success rate.

In reviewing the equity gaps for our department, there is opportunity to improve and do better.

In comparing the Spring 2023 to the Spring 2024 semester, we saw an increase in equity gaps with our African-American/Black Non-Hispanic students (7% increase), our Hispanic/Latino students (7% increase) and our Midder Eastern or North African students (15% increase).

In comparing the Fall 2022 to the Fall 2023semester, we saw an decrease in equity gaps with our African-American/Black Non-Hispanic students (14% decrease) and our Hispanic/Latino students (3% decrease).

Please discuss any equity gaps in access or success.

The ASL Department has Equity Gaps in the Success Rate in the following areas:

African-American/Black Non-Hispanic: Increase of Equity Gap of 7% from the Spring 2023 to Spring 2024 semester and decrease of Equity Gap of 14% from the Fall 2022 to Fall 2023 semester.

Hispanic/Latino: Increase of Equity Gap of 7% from the Spring 2023 to Spring 2024 semester and decrease of Equity Gap of 3% from the Fall 2022 to Fall 2023 semester.

Middle Eastern or North African: Increase of Equity Gap of 15% from the Spring 2023 to Spring 2024 semester and no noted Equity Gap from the Fall 2022 to Fall 2023 semester.

What action will the department or discipline take to address these equity gaps?

Equity gaps and steps to decrease them will be discussed at department meetings as well of encouragement of faculty members to participate in diversity training such as the EMTLI program and others offered through the college. We will also discuss and review current curriculum and SLOs to make sure they best serve the diverse student population at Cuyamaca College.

Please describe any enrollment changes (increases/decreases) over the past year and the context for these changes.

In comparing the Spring 2023 to Spring 2024 semester, we had a 4% increase in enrollment and an 11% increase in enrollment in comparing the Fall 2022 to the Fall 2023 semester. We also increased enrollment in our summer courses by adding an additional course to our summer offerings. We have introduced in-person courses back into our program and continue to have strong enrollment with our CCAP offerings with Steele Canyon High School.

What has this data revealed about the progress of the program review goals you set?

The increase in Equity Gaps has added to our Program Goals so that decreasing becomes a high priority along with increasing enrollment and course offerings.

Distance Education Course Success (If Applicable)

If your department offers distance education classes, how do you ensure Regular and Substantive Interaction (RSI) is being implemented?

Due to the visual nature of American Sign Language, many course interactions occur during via video including assignment submissions and instructor feedback. Clear deadlines are outlined for students and feedback is given in a timely manner. Interactive signed discussion boards are also used to encourage interaction with classmates. Online instructors also offer office hours for students.
