What are the actual duties and responsibilities that are specific to this requested position that you would like to highlight to help the Classified Hiring Priorities Committee understand the need for this position? How does the lack of this position impact the program's or service area's ability to serve students? (300 words or less)

Our department has a 9 acre field site with several different planted areas and irrigation systems. Our current Specialty Lab Tech III (SLT3) is largely occupied with trying to keep up with the demands of our field site and its mix of a greenhouse that has serious corrosion after three years of installation, newly installed irrigation with smart controller, older standalone irrigation systems in various states of disrepair, a growing ground that supplies our retail nursery and over 13 grant funded student interns and 19 lab classes that utilize student lab technicians. We need a second person so we can better support our lab classes and our student success and retention.

Our program was remodeled and while that is largely a positive thing, it has created a great deal of disruption in operation because of the need to connect old irrigation to new irrigation and because we are struggling with greenhouse maintenance. Fortunately, our enrollment is at pre-pandemic levels and this is wonderful but means we have more students needing attention for our largely lab-based classes. Workloads have always been tight. In the past, some of our staff and faculty have had retired spouses who volunteer nearly full-time to help with irrigation and field maintenance. None of our current staff/faculty have a partner willing to fill a volunteer full-time role.
