


CUYAMACA COLLEGE JOB PLACEMENT information for faculty





Angela Tilley-Ruiz is Cuyamaca's Job Placement Case Manager (JPCM). She supports students and alumni in securing jobs with sustainable wages linked to their fields of study.

The JPCM provides coaching and job-readiness training through individual career coaching, workshops on campus, classroom presentations, and employment events.

INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIPS

The JPCM builds partnerships with local businesses to inform them of Cuyamaca's excellent programs and helps them locate skilled students. Knowing industry needs and what skills are required to be successful and advance in their business is critical to not just coaching students, but also helping us shape curriculum.

Angela is present at Advisory Board meetings: inviting business partners she has developed a working relationship with as well as building new relationships with the program coordinator's and instructor's employer contacts.

The JPCM establishes and strengthens the ties between industry and Cuyamaca. We want local businesses to stay competitive by hiring the most prepared and engaged employees. This affects key business outcomes such as high productivity, profitability, and customer satisfaction. With engaged employees, employers see lower turnover rates, less safety incidents, and lower absenteeism in the workplace.



The JPCM needs help from faculty in tracking student employment! To continue the support and funding from the state and region to keep a Job Placement Case Manager on campus, collaboration with instructors is key.

JCPM must provide data proving the metrics have been met. The California Community College Chancellor's Office designed the outcome metrics for Strong Workforce. JPCM's are tasked to provide students with the support needed to identify occupations in their field of study and ultimately, become gainfully employed.

WAYS FOR FACULTY TO PARTNER WITH US

- CCN Registration assignment: Have students register on <u>Cuyamaca's free job board College</u>

 <u>Central Network (CCN)</u> where they can access job and internship opportunities.
- **Resume assignments**: Have students upload their resumes on <u>CCN</u> to get them reviewed by Career Center and Tutoring Center staff.
- Advisory Board & Employer meetings: More students are placed when the JPCM participates in meetings between employers and instructors. JPCM can assist in identifying employers to invite.
- In-class visits: Career Center can host a workshop in your class OR a brief info session.
- Employer Panels or Guest Speakers: Career Center coordinates employer visits to your class.
- Hiring Events: Companies want to visit your class and conduct on-the-spot interviews!
