THESE CHANGES MAY IMPACT YOU AND YOUR FINANCIAL AID STATUS.

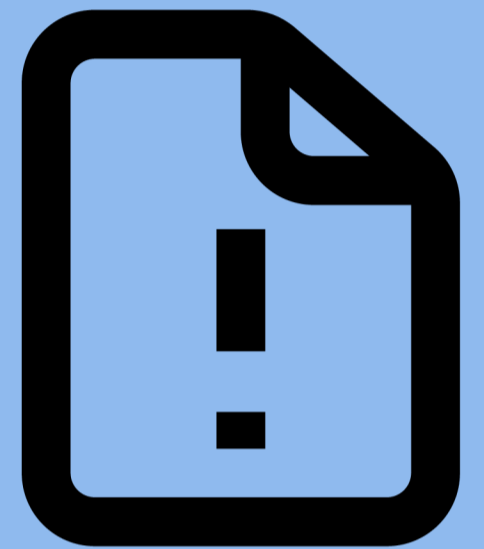
HOME LOCATION

Your home location is the college where your major is at.



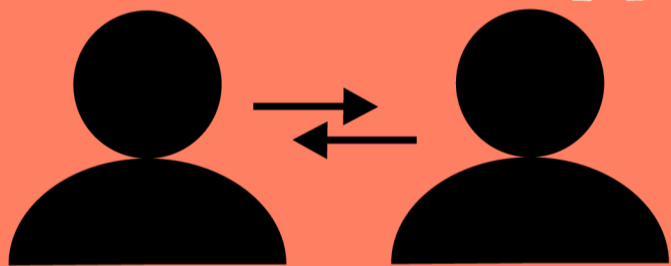
If you are receiving Financial Aid - your aid will come from the college that your major is declared with.

IMPORTANT CHANGES & REMINDERS:



- You may only change your major once per semester.
- Your Major is locked in for the semester after the first 2 weeks. Any changes to your major after the first 2 weeks will be effective the following semester.
- Financial Aid only covers the courses required for your major/educational goal.
- Requests to change your major must be done with a counselor during an appointment. This cannot be processed during Drop-In.

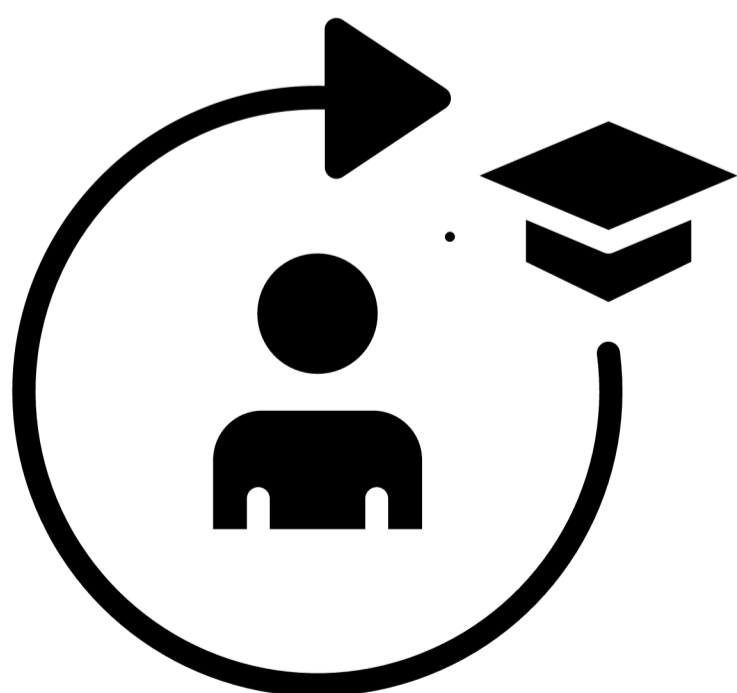
MUST MEET WITH A COUNSELOR



Make a Counseling Appointment to update your education plan and change your major. If you are in a specialized program (EOP&S, CalWORKs, DSPS, Athletics, Veterans) meet with a counselor in that program.
